## Mandatory Safety Instructions for Business Visits COVID-19

Read, understand, ask before complete filling online visit form and fully comply with.

SESAME has the write to stop your visit if you violate or break any of these instructions:

- 1- Aman application downloaded and active on your mobile, (security on the main gate will make sure of it).
- 2- If Aman application showed <u>High or Extreme high risk</u>, in this case, you will not be able to enter SESAME unless 14 days at least elapsed from the date of exposure date, so, take care and be careful, (security on the main gate will make sure of that as well).
- 3- Do you suffer from fever, cough and/ or difficulty in breathing? Surveillance staff at the main gate will check the temperature of anybody entering the premises.
- 4- YOU MUST bring at least one KN95 and must not be shared with others under any circumstances.
- 5- Mask is compulsory in all common areas; minimum safety distance of **2** m should be kept at all times.
- 6- Respect sneezing or coughing guidelines:
  - a. **Before**: Mask + Hands on your face+ Face down and away from others or surfaces.
  - b. Sneeze or cough,
  - c. After: Clean your hands directly.
- 7- No more than **two** people in one big room, if this will not be the case, a prior approval from safety officer is required. Working in open areas is limited by safe physical distancing.
- 8- Don't touch your face and if you are obliged to do so, you should clean in advance your hands appropriately.
- 9- Do not share with others any type of cigarettes, food or beverage and clean other shared tools.
- 10-Upon certain circumstances, you might subject to new instructions on your arrival and such instructions will not affect your plan at all.
- 11-You should work under the full supervision of the staff member in charge and the safety officer will make sure of your compliance with the above mentioned instructions.
