

# Synchrotron-light for Experimental Science and Applications in the Middle East

## Basic safety instructions for all visitors to SESAME

After you have completed the online visit request form, please read the following instructions before arrival to SESAME. If anything is unclear, you should ensure to ask your host for clarification.

#### General instructions

- Everyone must know:
  - o the name of your host, their mobile number, and office location
  - o the location of the nearest and safe emergency exit, and the emergency assembly point
  - the closest first aid box
  - what activities they will be permitted to perform
- Contractors must attend a 30 minute safety presentation before starting any planned work, with advance coordination between the procurement unit, the host and the safety office
- If you suffer from any chronic or infectious diseases or have any metal implants, please inform the safety
  office.
- When near a high magnetic field (indicated by a precaution sign), keep away any credit cards and any other items sensitive to magnetic fields.
- At all times, follow the instructions of your host
- You should never wear headphones or earpieces so that you can hear any broadcast or spoken instructions
- Do not touch or step on wires or cables, or unplug any data or power cables for any electric tool or electronic
  device
- Do not remove or change the location of any non-related equipment or objects or shielding material or else.
- Pay attention to any precaution tapes or signs and inform the safety office if you plan to place any tapes or signs related to your work
- Take care of your belongings

#### In case of an emergency

- In case of an ALARM bell: leave the tunnels and the building calmly, making sure to take care of people who are under your responsibility
- If you notice any safety issues or any risks, please notify your host
- In case of an emergency, inform your host or the safety office

## Instructions for activities inside the Main Hall

- You should only visit areas permitted by your host
- It is not permitted to access the roofs of the tunnels except for specific work activities, or in case of an evacuation while you are in the service area or tunnels
- Wear any personal protective equipment that you are instructed to
- Do not press any emergency push button or any other button unrelated to your work
- Keep the workplace clean and in order at all times
- Before dealing with electromechanical or general tools, or any chemicals you will be required to undertake further safety training and risk assessment

#### Food, drink and smoking

- Alcohol and drugs must not be consumed at SESAME, nor should you come to SESAME under any form of intoxication
- Eating is NOT allowed inside the Experimental Hall
- Drinking is only allowed in the Experimental Hall from a closed bottle or mug
- Drinking is not permitted inside the tunnels
- Smoking is permitted ONLY in the designated area outside the building

#### Clothing

- Closed toe, flat shoes should be worn: open toed shoes and very high heels are not permitted
- Long hair should be tied back
